Psalm 32:1, 2 "Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man to whom the lord does not impute iniquity. And in whose spirit there is no deceit."

Psalm 103:12 "As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us."

Isaiah 38:17 "For you have cast all my sins behind your back."

Jeremiah 31:31-34 "Behold the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Judah—not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the Lord. 'But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: 'I will put my law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying "Know the Lord," for they all shall know Me, from the least of them, says the Lord. 'For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more."

Micah 7:19 "He will again have compassion on us, and subdue our iniquities. You will cast all our sins into the depths of the sea."

John 1:29 "The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, 'Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.""

Romans 4:7,8 "Blessed are those whose lawle ss deeds are forgiven, and whose sins are covered; Blessed is the man to whom the Lord shall not impute sin."

Ephesians 1:7 "In Him we have redemption through His blood the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace.

Ephesians 4:32 "And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another as God in Christ forgave you.

2 Corinthians 5:19 "that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of rec onciliation."

Colossians 1:14 "in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins."

Colossians 2:13 "And you being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you a ll the trespasses."

Colossians 3:13 "bearing with one another, and forgiving one another; even as Christ forgave you, so you must also do."

Hebrews 1:3 "who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high."

Hebrews 7:27 "who does not need daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the people's, for this He did once for all when He offered up Himself."

Hebrews 8:10-12 "For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord; I will put My laws in their mind and write them on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. None of them shall teach his neighbor, and none his brother, saying 'Know the Lord,' for all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them. For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more."

Hebrews 10:12 "But this Man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God."

Hebrews 10:14 "For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being s anctified."

Hebrews 10:17-18 "then adds, 'Their sin and lawless deeds I will remember no more'. Now where there is remission of these, there is no longer an offering for sin."

2 Peter 1:9 "For he who lacks these things is shortsighted, even to blindness, and has forgotten that he was cleansed from his old sins."

1 John 2:12 "I write to you, little children, because your sins are forgiven you for His name's sake."
